Required Equipment

- o Connect ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and check the indicator lights for a successful connection .
- o Router Configuration: Access the router's web interface (usually 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to configure settings. Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you prioritize streaming, gaming, or video calls .
