

Adding a connector to the fiber optic cable

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Cleaving and Placing the Fiber

o Use a fiber cleaver to cut the fiber to the precise length. Place the fiber in a holding block or fixture to stabilize it for polishing .

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Polishing the Fiber End-Face

o Polish the fiber in a figure-8 motion using progressively finer polishing films. The polish type (UPC or APC) affects return loss and reflection: UPC is slightly domed, APC is angled at 8° for minimal back-reflection .

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Assembling the Connector

o Attach the outer housing, rotate or screw it as required (depending on connector type), and secure the fiber in place. Ensure alignment marks match to prevent misalignment .

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Cleaning and Testing

o Clean the end-face with alcohol and fiber cleaning tools. Test the connection using an optical power meter or OTDR to verify low insertion loss and proper signal transmission .

Connector Types and Considerations

- o LC: Small form factor, latch mechanism, common in data centers.
- o SC: Push-pull mechanism, widely used in single-mode networks.
- o FC: Threaded, secure for high-vibration environments.
- o MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications .
