- o Transceiver temperature
 - o Supply voltage
 - o Transmit optical power
 - o Receive optical power
 - o Transmit bias current
- These parameters are continuously compared against predefined warning and alarm thresholds, and alerts can be generated if values exceed safe limits. This functionality is essential for maintaining network reliability and preventing downtime.

Standards and Compliance

SFP modules with remote monitoring typically comply with the SFF-8472 Multi-Source Agreement (MSA), which standardizes the DOM/DDM interface and ensures interoperability across different vendors . Compliance with CE, FCC, and RoHS standards is also common, ensuring safety and environmental adherence.

Practical Implications

- o Deployment Flexibility: DOM-enabled SFPs allow network administrators to monitor module health without physical inspection.
- o Compatibility: Most commercial and industrial SFP modules supporting DOM/DDM are compatible with a wide range of switches and routers from vendors like Cisco, Juniper, and HPE .

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o Distance and Type: DOM support is available for both single-mode and multimode fibers, covering distances from hundreds of meters to over 160 km depending on the module type .
