Modifying Cable Trays in 3D CAD

In 3D CAD environments such as MagiCAD or Cabling modules, you can modify existing cable trays by adjusting alignment, elevation, offsets, bends, and branches. Pre-defining routing preferences allows for faster edits, and the software supports automatic crossings, elevation adjustments, and copying or moving entire branches to resolve conflicts or optimize routing . Collision control ensures that trays do not overlap improperly, and miter joints can be forced instead of curves for precise connections .

Modifying Cable Trays in AutoCAD

For AutoCAD MEP, select the cable tray segment you want to modify, then use the Modify Cable Tray command from the Cable Tray tab. In the dialog box, you can change the system, adjust properties, or reroute segments. The Properties palette allows you to specify system types for conduits or trays, ensuring consistency across the design . Dynamic blocks can also be used to handle multiple tray sizes and configurations, reducing the need for multiple static blocks and improving drawing efficiency .

Cutting, Joining, and Routing

- o Cut Tool: Splits a straight cable tray into two pieces at a selected point, visualizing the cut plane for accuracy .
- o Join/Connect: Use commands like Connect (P) or Join (J) to link a new tray segment to an existing node, ensuring continuity.
- o Routing: Start from a defined point, and the software automatically inserts straight parts, bends, or risers according to the tray specification. Reference points can be adjusted for precise placement .

Best Practices

- o Maintain a minimum spacing of 10 cm between trays to allow for air jumps and visibility .
 - o Avoid overlapping or partially duplicated tray parts, as this can cause routing errors or performance issues .
 - o Use dynamic blocks and LISP automation in AutoCAD to speed up repetitive modifications and maintain accuracy .
 - o Always check for collisions and adjust elevations to coordinate with other disciplines in the same 3D space .
- By following these methods, CAD users can efficiently modify cable tray layouts, maintain design integrity, and improve coordination across electrical and MEP projects.
