They provide fireproof, low smoke, water, and gas-tight sealing, and are faster and more economical than traditional stuffing methods . 4. Cable Entry Seals Roxtec-style sealing modules feature removable layers for precise fitting to cables or pipes of varying sizes. They allow pre-terminated cables to pass through without cutting connectors, reducing installation time and risk of leaks. These seals also protect against vibration, EMI, and signal loss, making them ideal for sensitive electronic installations .
