- o MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On / Multi-Fiber Termination Push-On): Multi-fiber connectors handling 8, 12, 16, or 24 fibers per connector. Essential for high-speed parallel transmission in backbone networks and data centers. MTP is an enhanced version with lower insertion loss and higher durability. Other connectors like ST (Straight Tip) and FC (Ferrule Connector) may still be used in legacy or specialized installations, but SC, LC, and MPO/MTP dominate modern deployments.

Practical Considerations

- o Polish Type: Matching UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact) is critical to minimize signal loss.
- o Splicing and Termination: Hollow-core fibers require careful handling during splicing to avoid damage to the photonic cladding.
- o Deployment Context: In Syria, these connectors are used in FTTP networks, data centers, and utility infrastructure projects, including UNDOF fiber layouts.
