 - o Mounting options include wall-mounted, floor-mounted, flush-mounted, and surface-mounted configurations, depending on the application and space availability .
 - o Enclosures often include TH35x7.5 symmetrical rails for modular components and compact frames for multiple rows of modules .

 - o Many boxes include transparent windows for visual inspection, neutral and earth copper bars, and guide rails for easy installation .
 - o Industrial models allow front access for maintenance, capacity expansion, and operation under higher temperatures (up to +70°C for short periods) and humidity (up to 90% at +20°C) .

 - o Most distribution boxes conform to IEC, low-voltage directives (2014/35/EU), and GB7251.3-2006 standards, ensuring compatibility with international low-voltage electrical installations .
 - o For DRC-specific projects, engineers should verify local wiring regulations and standards, as international specifications are generally applicable but may require adaptation .
