Role of the ONT

Fiber optic internet uses an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) instead of a traditional modem. The ONT converts the incoming light signals from the fiber optic cable into digital Ethernet data that your devices can use . It also authenticates your connection with the internet service provider and securely terminates the fiber line inside your home . Unlike traditional modems, the ONT does not typically provide Wi-Fi or manage multiple devices directly .

Role of the Router

A router is still necessary because it manages your home network and distributes the internet connection to multiple devices, either via Wi-Fi or Ethernet cables . Key functions of a router include:

- o Creating a Local Area Network (LAN): Connecting multiple devices like computers, smartphones, and smart TVs within your home.
- o Assigning IP addresses: Using DHCP to ensure each device has a unique address for communication.
- o Directing internet traffic: Routing data between your devices and the ONT, and managing internal device-to-device communication.
- o Providing Wi-Fi: Broadcasting wireless signals for devices that are not physically connected.
- o Security: Offering firewalls, VPN support, and other protections for your network . Without a router, you could generally only connect a single device directly to the ONT via Ethernet, limiting network functionality and wireless access .

Compatibility Considerations

To fully utilize fiber internet speeds, your router should support gigabit Ethernet and modern Wi-Fi standards like Wi-Fi 6 or 6E . Routers designed for DSL or cable connections will not work with fiber because they lack the appropriate WAN port and speed support . Some ISPs provide combined ONT-router devices, but using a separate high-quality router can improve performance, coverage, and network management .
