Design and Materials

- o Material: Typically made of steel for durability and load-bearing capacity, sometimes with protective coatings to resist corrosion .
- o Snap-on or adjustable brackets: Many frames feature modular snap-fit joints or adjustable mounting brackets to allow rapid deployment and flexible positioning within the duct .
- o Mounting hardware: Standard fixing uses M6x16 bolts, nuts, and star washers to secure the frame to the duct at any desired position .

Installation Guidelines

- o Positioning: Place the first and last support stands approximately 500mm from each end of the duct section to prevent sagging .
- o Leveling: Use a spirit level to ensure the frame is horizontal and aligned with adjacent duct sections .
- o Securing: Tighten nuts and bolts to lock the frame in place. Snap-on covers or clips may be used for additional protection .
- o Deburring: Ensure all cut edges of the duct are smooth to avoid damaging fiber cables during installation .
- o Compatibility: Frames are designed to fit a variety of duct sizes and can be mounted on walls, ceilings, or within racks depending on the network layout .
