

Fiber Optic Cable Junction Box Wiring Steps

- o Maintain the minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss or fiber breakage .

- o Install adapters and connectors (SC, LC, FC, or ST types) in the splice tray or adapter slots .
- o Organize slack by winding excess fiber neatly in the tray, avoiding tight loops or entanglement .

- o Route fibers along the internal guides of the box to prevent stress and maintain signal integrity .
- o Label each fiber clearly to identify incoming and outgoing connections, which simplifies future maintenance .

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Step 6: Testing and Verification

- o Check continuity and signal quality using an optical power meter or OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) to ensure proper connections .
- o Secure the box cover and verify that all cables are protected from dust, moisture, and accidental handling .
