

Article Overview

Configuring a fiber optic router board involves connecting the ONT or OLT, setting up VLANs and bridges, assigning IP addresses, and ensuring proper SFP interface settings for optimal network performance.

Connecting the Router to Fiber

Start by identifying your fiber connection type. Most fiber networks use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) for home setups or an Optical Line Terminal (OLT) for enterprise networks. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT or OLT port. Then, use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT/OLT to the router's WAN port or SFP port if your router supports fiber input . Power on both devices and wait for the status lights to stabilize.

Accessing Router Settings

Open a web browser and enter the router's default IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1) to access the admin panel. Login credentials are typically admin/admin unless changed by the manufacturer . This interface allows you to configure network settings, security, and VLANs.

VLAN and Bridge Configuration

For enterprise or ISP setups using a MikroTik RouterBoard, create a bridge interface (e.g., bridge1) to group ports connected to the OLT . Assign the relevant ports to this bridge. Next, configure VLANs:

- o VLAN for management: e.g., vlan1000 for the default OLT network segment (e.g., 192.168.20.0/24)
- o VLAN for clients: e.g., vlan2000 for subscriber traffic (e.g., 192.168.110.0/24) This ensures proper segmentation between management and client networks and allows you to change default OLT IPs safely .

SFP Interface Setup

If using SFP/SFP+ modules, ensure both ends of the fiber link have compatible transceivers. Configure the SFP interface in the router, enabling auto-negotiation and selecting the correct wavelength (e.g., 1310 nm for single-mode fiber) for short-distance connections . Test the link using a power meter and optical light source to measure signal loss.

Additional Configuration Steps

- o Firmware update: Ensure the router board firmware is up-to-date for stability and security .
- o Wi-Fi and security: Set strong passwords and configure Wi-Fi settings if applicable.



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- o IP assignment: Assign static or DHCP IPs for management and client VLANs.
- o Testing: Verify internet connectivity by connecting a device to the router and performing a speed test .

Best Practices

- o Avoid bending or damaging fiber cables; they are fragile .
- o Place the router centrally for optimal Wi-Fi coverage.
- o Document VLAN IDs, IP ranges, and bridge configurations for future troubleshooting.
- o For enterprise setups, follow OLT-specific guides to ensure seamless integration with the ISP network . By following these steps, your fiber optic router board will be properly configured for both home and enterprise networks, ensuring high-speed, secure, and reliable connectivity.
