Overview

Fiji OEM SFP modules are small form-factor pluggable (SFP) transceivers manufactured by original optical component suppliers and branded for networking vendors. They convert electrical signals into optical signals (and vice versa), enabling high-speed data transmission over fiber or copper cables. These modules are hot-swappable, allowing easy installation or replacement without powering down equipment, and are designed to meet Multi-Source Agreement (MSA) standards for interoperability .

- o SFP+ (10G): Enhanced version supporting up to 10 Gbps while retaining the same physical form factor as SFP .

- o Form factor variety: Includes SFP, SFP+, QSFP, CFP, and DWDM transceivers to suit different network architectures .

Fiber Type and Distance

- o Single-mode fiber (SMF): Ideal for long-distance connections, campus networks, and building-to-building links .
- o Multi-mode fiber (MMF): Best for shorter distances such as intra-floor or data room connections .
- o Extended reach options: Some SFP modules use tunable lasers or coherent technology to extend transmission distances beyond conventional limits, often exceeding 15 km .

Compatibility and Vendor Support

Fiji OEM SFP modules are certified for use with major networking vendors including Cisco, Juniper, Arista, Nokia, and Huawei. They are rigorously tested to ensure full compatibility with vendor systems, minimizing link failures and ensuring reliable high-speed connectivity .

- o Backward compatibility: SFP+ ports can accept 1G SFP modules, but 10G SFP+ modules cannot operate in

1G SFP ports .

o Energy-efficient design: Optimized to reduce power consumption while maintaining performance .

o Proper handling: Handle modules by the edges and avoid touching optical surfaces to prevent damage .

o Cleaning: Use lint-free cloths or optical cleaning tools to remove dust and debris before installation .

o Environmental considerations: Ensure recommended temperature and humidity levels to maintain reliability and prevent overheating .

o Testing: Every fiber connection should be tested for low signal loss and long-term stability before deployment .
