They are often solid, bare conductors, which allows them to handle high currents efficiently. Some busbars are dust-proof or color-coded to simplify identification and maintenance .

Installation and Mounting

Busbars are mounted inside a dedicated enclosure or distribution box to ensure safety, as they are usually uninsulated . They can be connected using mechanical lugs or exothermic welding (Cadweld) for secure and reliable connections . Flexible mounting options allow optimized placement within racks or panels, and specialized connectors can facilitate compact installations where space is limited .
