- o Pre-terminated assemblies and patch cables cost more due to factory termination and connector type .
- o Long-term value: While multimode fiber is more expensive per foot than single-mode fiber, it often reduces total link costs because transceivers are cheaper and installation is simpler for short-distance indoor networks .
- o Regional pricing: Costs can vary by region, with the Midwest generally lower than the Northeast or West Coast in the U.S. .
