

How to add a distribution box to your home

- o Arrange wiring neatly: Use cable ties to prevent tangling and allow space for heat dissipation .
- o Label circuits: Clearly mark each circuit for easier maintenance and troubleshooting .

Testing and Safety Checks

Before powering the system, perform the following tests:

- o Insulation resistance test: Verify insulation between wires and the box meets standards .
- o Circuit on/off test: Use a multimeter to ensure all circuits function correctly and there are no short circuits .
- o Visual inspection: Check for loose connections, proper grounding, and correct breaker installation .
