

How to fix cable trays with brackets

 - o For ceiling brackets, connect the bracket to a threaded rod using extension nuts, then secure it to the ceiling or intermediate support .

- o **Organize Cables:** Use cable tie mounts or clips to prevent cables from slipping out and to maintain a tidy installation .
