

How to hide the Wi-Fi on a fiber optic router

You can hide your Wi-Fi network by disabling SSID broadcast in your router's settings, making it invisible to nearby devices.

Steps to Hide Your Wi-Fi Network

- o Access Your Router Settings Open a web browser and enter your router's IP address, usually 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1. If unsure, check the label on your router or the manual for the default IP address .
- o Log In to the Router Enter your username and password. If you haven't changed them, the default is often admin with a blank password or as specified in the manual .
- o Navigate to Wireless Settings Look for sections labeled Home, Wireless, WLAN, or Wi-Fi Settings.
- o Disable SSID Broadcast Find the option to broadcast SSID and uncheck it. This prevents your network name from appearing in device scans .
- o Save Settings and Reboot Apply the changes and restart your router if necessary. Devices that were previously connected may need to manually enter the network name (SSID) to reconnect.

Additional Tips

- o Maintain Security: Even with SSID hidden, always use strong WPA2 or WPA3 encryption and a secure password.
- o Signal Considerations: Hiding the SSID does not affect signal strength, but placing the router in a well-ventilated, open area ensures optimal performance .
- o Physical Hiding: If you also want to hide the router itself, use decorative baskets, boxes with ventilation, or open shelving to disguise it without blocking the Wi-Fi signal . Avoid metal or dense materials that can interfere with the signal. By following these steps, your Wi-Fi network will be invisible to casual users, enhancing privacy while maintaining connectivity for authorized devices.
