

How to install the control panel for the distribution box

Article Overview

Proper installation of a control panel ensures safe, organized, and reliable distribution of electrical power while complying with safety standards and manufacturer specifications.

Preparation and Safety Measures

Before installation, ensure all materials and components are inspected for compliance with approved submittals and free from damage. Conduct a risk assessment and implement mitigation strategies for personnel and equipment safety. All workers should wear PPE and use non-conductive tools when handling electrical components. Live power work is prohibited, and temporary power connections should use ELCBs and industrial connectors to prevent hazards. Maintain a clean workspace and provide adequate barricades and signage around the installation area .

Panel Placement and Mounting

- o Location: Install the panel in a dry, accessible area with good ventilation, typically at a height of ~1.5 meters for easy access .
- o Mounting: For floor-mounted panels, mark fixing holes on the concrete plinth; for wall-mounted panels, mark based on approved shop drawings. Align and fix the panel securely using approved methods. Ensure sufficient clearance around the panel for future maintenance .
- o Protection: Keep water pipes and other services away from the panel or provide protection against accidental leaks .

Electrical Connections

- o Cable Glanding and Termination: Use the glanding plate to secure power and earthing cables. Terminate all connections according to manufacturer specifications and torque values .
- o Component Verification: Check all internal components (MCCB, MCB, relays, fuses, meters, CTs, contactors, terminals) against approved drawings for correct rating and size. Any internal modifications should be performed only by the manufacturer's representative .
- o Labeling: Identify incoming and outgoing cables, breakers, and panel components according to approved shop drawings to facilitate maintenance and troubleshooting .

Pre-Commissioning and Testing

- o Visual Inspection: Ensure the panel is clean, free from debris, and all components are properly installed .
- o Cold Testing: Check insulation resistance of cables, verify termination tightness, and confirm busbar joint

- o Documentation: Record installation details, component ratings, and inspection results for future reference and regulatory compliance .
