

How to jumper wires on a terminal box

- o Push the jumper firmly to ensure it makes proper contact with the terminals.
- o Secure the connection by tightening any screws if using screw-terminal jumpers, or ensure spring-loaded jumpers are fully engaged .
- o Check continuity across the connected terminals to confirm a proper electrical connection.

- o Custom Configurations: For alternating or non-standard terminal arrangements, you can create custom jumpers using ring terminals or modified bus bars, ensuring proper insulation and secure connections .
- o Color Coding: Use different colored jumpers for positive, negative, or signal lines to minimize wiring mistakes . By following these steps and selecting the correct jumper type, you can safely and efficiently jumper wires on a terminal box, ensuring reliable power distribution and organized wiring.
