

How to replace a router with a fiber optic cable from a telecom company

Fiber optic internet requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the light signals from the fiber cable into electrical signals that your router can use . The ONT is installed and activated by your telecom provider, and it is essential for the connection; a traditional router or direct fiber cable cannot replace it .

Using Your Own Router

You can connect almost any modern router to the ONT via an Ethernet WAN port, provided it supports the speeds of your fiber plan . Key considerations include:

- o WAN Port Compatibility: Your router must have a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port to handle typical fiber speeds. For multi-gigabit plans, routers with 2.5 GbE or higher may be required .
- o Wi-Fi Standards: Wi-Fi 6 or 6E routers are recommended for optimal speed, efficiency, and device management .
- o ISP Settings: Some ISPs require specific VLAN, PPPoE, or IPoE configurations. You may need to enter these settings manually in your router's admin panel .
- o Additional Services: If your ISP provides TV or VoIP, replacing the router may complicate these services, as they often rely on the ISP's equipment for proper configuration .

- o Ensure the ONT is installed and active by your ISP.
- o Connect your router's WAN port to the ONT using an Ethernet cable.
- o Configure any required ISP-specific settings (VLAN, PPPoE, DHCP).
- o Test your connection to confirm full speed and stability.
