

How to use a cable tray cable puller

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Plan the Cable Route Before pulling, inspect the cable tray layout and identify bends, supports, and potential friction points. Ensure the tray is clear of debris and that all supports are properly spaced according to NEC standards to prevent sagging or cable damage (). 2. Prepare the Pulling Rope or Tag Line Attach a pull rope or tag line to the cable using a secure eye or carabiner. If using a mechanical puller, connect the cable to the pulling mechanism according to the manufacturer's instructions (). For long runs, pre-install eyebolts or guide points along the tray to help guide the rope. 3. Use a Cable Puller or Wire Feeder Tool Mechanical cable pullers, like the UT10 Ultra Tugger(R), can generate significant pulling force (up to 10,000 lb) to move cables through long or heavy runs (). Ensure the puller is grounded and operated according to safety instructions. Keep hands and visitors clear of moving parts. 4. Apply Lubrication if Needed For long runs or multiple bends, use a suitable cable lubricant to reduce friction and prevent cable damage. Lubrication helps maintain the cable's integrity and reduces the effort required to pull (). 5. Pull the Cable Smoothly Operate the puller or have a team pull the rope steadily. Avoid jerking or sudden movements, which can damage the cable or connectors. Monitor the cable for kinks or snags and adjust as necessary. 6. Manage Multiple Cables If pulling multiple cables, leave adequate clearance between them to prevent jamming. Use the jam ratio method to calculate safe spacing in bends (). For long runs, tie successive ropes to the previous rope's eye to continue pulling additional cables efficiently (). 7. Secure and Terminate Once the cable reaches its destination, secure it in the tray using cable ties or clamps. Check for proper bend radius and tension to ensure long-term reliability ().
