

How to wire the dimmer switch module

Safety First

Before starting, turn off the circuit breaker controlling the light fixture and verify the power is off using a non-contact voltage tester. This prevents electrical shock and ensures safe handling of wires .

Tools and Materials

- o Screwdrivers (Phillips and flathead)
- o Wire strippers
- o Wire nuts
- o Non-contact voltage tester
- o Electrical tape

Single-Pole Dimmer Wiring

- o Remove the old switch: Unscrew the faceplate and gently pull out the existing switch from the electrical box .
- o Identify wires: Typically, you will see two black wires (line and load) and a bare copper or green ground wire .
- o Connect the ground: Attach the dimmer's green wire to the bare copper or green wire in the box using a wire nut .
- o Connect line and load wires: Match the dimmer's black and red wires to the two black wires in the box. Follow the manufacturer's instructions to determine which is line and which is load, then secure with wire nuts .
- o Secure the switch: Carefully fold the wires into the box, attach the dimmer to the electrical box with screws, and install the faceplate .
- o Restore power and test: Turn the circuit breaker back on and test the dimmer across its full range .

3-Way Dimmer Wiring

- o Identify wires: A 3-way setup has one common wire, two traveler wires, and a ground wire .
- o Connect the ground: Attach the dimmer's green wire to the box ground.
- o Connect the common wire: This wire remains energized regardless of switch position and must be connected to the dimmer's designated common terminal, usually marked or colored differently .
- o Connect traveler wires: The remaining two wires can be connected to the dimmer's traveler terminals; their positions are usually interchangeable .



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o Secure and test: Fold wires carefully, mount the dimmer, attach the faceplate, restore power, and test the dimmer's functionality .

Bulb Compatibility

- o Incandescent and halogen bulbs: Standard dimmers work well.
- o LED or CFL bulbs: Use dimmers rated for these types to prevent flickering or buzzing .
- o Low-voltage or fluorescent lighting: May require specialized dimming ballasts or electronic low-voltage dimmers .

Tips

- o Always twist wire nuts tightly and ensure no copper is exposed .
- o For LED dimmers, some may require calibration to match the output curve to the connected load .
- o Keep wires neatly folded in the box to avoid pinching or damage . Following these steps ensures a safe, functional, and efficient dimmer switch installation for both single-pole and 3-way circuits.
