- o Inspect mechanical components: Verify that sliding doors, battery modules, and circuit breakers are properly seated and lubricated.
- o Use intelligent monitoring: Huawei modules provide real-time status of cooling and power systems via smart screens and NetEco/ECC UI, which can help identify components under stress that may contribute to noise .
