

Installation of Nordic Explosion-proof Distribution Boxes

Key Installation Steps

- o Professional Installation Only trained and certified electricians should install explosion-proof distribution boxes. These professionals must understand hazardous area classifications (Zone 1, Zone 2, Zone 21, Zone 22) and the specific explosion-proof rating required for the site .

- o Power Isolation Before installation, ensure the electrical supply is completely turned off to prevent electrocution or accidental ignition .

- o Cable Connection

- o Open the terminal chamber cover and connect cables through the cable glands to the terminal blocks.

- o Ensure all internal and external grounding wires are properly connected.

- o Use only explosion-proof certified cables resistant to flame, impact, and mechanical damage .

- o After wiring, close the cover and secure it with fasteners, tightening nuts to maintain the enclosure's integrity .

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- o Sealing and Protection

- o Protect explosion-proof joint surfaces during installation and maintenance; avoid scratches.

- o Apply anti-rust oil on joint surfaces after maintenance.

- o Ensure the box is installed with a maximum inclination of 5 degrees and, if outdoors, fit a rain cover to prevent water ingress .

- o Component and Wiring Standards

- o Use stainless steel enclosures (Baosteel 304 or higher) with a minimum thickness of 4 mm .

- o Maintain proper electrical clearance, creepage distances, and impact withstand voltage for all live conductors and terminals.

- o Use galvanized fasteners and neatly arrange secondary wiring with casing sequencing and nylon ties .

- o Load and Rating Compliance

- o Verify that the explosion-proof rating of the box matches the hazardous area classification. Installing a box with an inadequate rating can lead to catastrophic failure .

- o Avoid overloading the system; adhere to the manufacturer's specified electrical load limits .

- o No Unauthorized Modifications

- o Do not alter internal components, wiring, or sealing mechanisms. Unauthorized modifications can invalidate certifications and compromise safety .

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- o Regular Inspection and Maintenance
- o Inspect for damage, dust, or combustible buildup that could reduce heat dissipation.
- o Ensure proper ventilation and cleaning to maintain safety and functionality .

Safety and Compliance Considerations

- o Follow ATEX, IECEx, and NEC Class I/II Division standards for explosion-proof equipment .
 - o Ensure all certification documents are site-specific and not generic .
 - o Maintain a safe installation environment, away from heat sources, collision risks, and moisture-prone areas .
- By following these steps and adhering to standards, Nordic explosion-proof distribution boxes can be safely installed and maintained, providing reliable protection in hazardous industrial environments.
