According to the 2026 NEC(R) Section 392.18(F), a minimum of 12 inches of clearance above cable trays is required to permit proper access for installing and maintaining cables, unless exceptions apply for IT rooms, industrial settings, or special permissions from the authority having jurisdiction . This access ensures that cables can be safely added, removed, or repaired without obstruction.

- o Labor and Installation: Even if the tray and access system are purchased together, installation labor for maintaining the required clearance is usually billed separately. This includes cutting, leveling, or adjusting supports to meet code requirements and ensure safe access.

- o When budgeting, clarify with suppliers whether access provisions, such as raised floor integration or clearance adjustments, are included in the tray price.
- o For custom or multi-level installations, expect additional costs for supports, dividers, or modular adjustments to maintain proper access.
- o Ensure compliance with NEC(R) and ANSI/TIA/EIA standards to avoid costly rework due to insufficient clearance .
