- o Single-mode fiber (OS2): Typically \$0.09 to \$1.52 per foot, suitable for long-distance transmission .
- o Multimode fiber (OM3/OM4): Typically \$1 to \$6 per foot, used for shorter distances like data centers .
- o High-count cables (e.g., 288 fibers) or armored cables for harsh environments cost more due to additional materials and protection layers .
- o Pre-terminated cables are more expensive upfront but reduce labor costs significantly, as they are factory-tested and ready to plug in .
- o Installation costs can exceed material costs, especially for underground or complex indoor installations, sometimes accounting for 60-80% of total project expenses . Bulk purchases often reduce per-foot costs by 20-40%, and prices fluctuate based on raw material costs, fiber count, and environmental ratings .
