

List of Consumables for New Energy Cable Trays

Fasteners and Connectors

- o Insulating sleeves or bushings: Protect cables from abrasion at bends or entry points .
- o EPDM rubber bands or nylon washers: Provide isolation between aluminum trays and steel supports to prevent corrosion .
- o Non-toxic coatings: Low-VOC or powder coatings for environmental protection and long-term durability .

Support and Installation Accessories

- o Hangers, brackets, and support rods: Maintain tray alignment and proper span spacing, critical for long runs in solar or wind installations .
- o Spacer bars or rungs: Maintain cable separation and prevent sagging, especially in perforated or ladder trays .
- o Expansion joints: Accommodate thermal expansion in outdoor or long-span installations .

Environmental and Safety Consumables

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- o UV-resistant covers: Protect cables from sunlight in outdoor installations .
- o Fire-retardant coatings or sleeves: Enhance safety in high-voltage or battery energy storage systems .
- o Sealing compounds or gaskets: Prevent ingress of dust, moisture, or corrosive agents in sensitive areas .
