- o **Bend Radius:** Accessories should support the minimum bend radius for fiber and high-grade copper cables to prevent damage .
- o **Material and Environment:** Indoor installations may use standard steel or aluminum, while outdoor or corrosive environments require stainless steel, hot-dip galvanized, or coated materials .
- o **Fill Ratio:** Avoid overfilling trays; maintain a 40-50% fill ratio to ensure heat dissipation, prevent crushing, and allow easy maintenance .
