

Multi-layer cable tray installation scheme

Article Overview

Multi-layer cable trays are installed by carefully planning the layout, preparing materials, securing supports, and systematically layering cables while adhering to safety and load standards.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, review the approved shop drawings to determine the layout, length, and location of the cable trays and ladders in the building . Ensure all materials, including trays, ladders, fittings, and accessories, are inspected for damage and compliance with project specifications . Store trays horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports at intervals of one meter to prevent deformation and protect from moisture and sunlight .

Support Structure Installation

Install support structures such as struts, threaded rods, and hangers according to the design plan. Maximum support spacing typically ranges from 3.6 meters, with a load capacity per hanger between 318 kg to 340 kg depending on the tray type . Ensure supports are level and aligned to maintain proper tray positioning and stability.

Tray Assembly and Layering

- o Position the base tray on the supports and secure it using appropriate clamps or fasteners.
- o Install additional layers for multi-layer trays, ensuring each layer is properly aligned and spaced to prevent cable compression or interference .
- o Maintain minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the tray to avoid damage .
- o Use rung spacing of 150-230 mm for ladder-type trays to support instrumentation and control cables effectively .

Cable Installation

- o Lay cables in the tray according to the approved routing plan, keeping power and control cables separated if required.
- o Avoid overloading the tray; follow manufacturer specifications for maximum cable fill.
- o Secure cables with ties or clamps to prevent movement and maintain organization .

Safety and Compliance

- o Only qualified personnel should perform installation, following local electrical codes and safety regulations such as the Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) or relevant national standards .
- o Ensure proper grounding and bonding of the tray system to prevent electrical hazards.

o Verify that all components are compatible and tested together to ensure system integrity .

Final Checks

- o Inspect the installed trays for alignment, secure fastening, and proper cable placement.
- o Confirm that all documentation, including material verification and installation records, is complete before energizing the system . By following these steps, multi-layer cable trays can be installed safely, efficiently, and in compliance with engineering and safety standards, ensuring long-term reliability of the cable management system.
