

Nominal method for laying cables in cable trays

This method applies to cables installed on cable ladder, perforated cable tray or cleats provided that the cable is spaced more than $0.3 \times D$ (overall diameter of the cable) from the wall.

Therefore, it is more-common practice to place the fiber-optic cable in a separate duct installed in the tray, trench or conduit (usually plastic), or use a cable construction with an integral duct.
