An explosion-proof secondary distribution box is a robust electrical enclosure designed to safely distribute power in hazardous areas, certified to prevent ignition of explosive atmospheres.

Overview

A secondary distribution box (also called a distribution board, DB box, or panel board) divides electrical power into subsidiary circuits while providing protection via fuses or circuit breakers. When designed as explosion-proof (Ex d), the enclosure prevents sparks or flames from escaping, making it suitable for hazardous zones such as Zone 1, Zone 2, Zone 21, and Zone 22, or Class I and II Division 1 areas .

- o **Materials:** Typically made from stainless steel, copper-free aluminum, GRP, or cast iron, offering high corrosion resistance, impact strength, and durability in extreme environments .
- o **Certifications:** Certified under ATEX, IECEx, and UL standards, ensuring compliance with global safety regulations .
- o **Protection Ratings:** High IP ratings (e.g., IP66) protect against dust and water ingress, suitable for indoor and outdoor installations .
- o **Design:** Flameproof joints, specialized hinges, and modular configurations allow safe operation, easy maintenance, and flexible installation .
- o **Components:** Can include circuit breakers, fuses, terminals, and busbars, tailored to client requirements .

- o Regular inspection and maintenance are recommended to preserve flameproof performance .
