Power Transmission Towers

Material Costs:

- Installation Costs:

For example, a 35-meter, 110kV lattice tower weighing 35 tons at \$1,200/ton has a base cost of \$42,000; adding foundation (\$18,000), hardware (\$8,500), and installation (\$10,500) brings the total installed cost to \$79,000 ().
