

Price of all indoor fiber optic cable connections

Indoor fiber optic cable typically costs between \$1 and \$6 per foot at retail, with wholesale prices ranging from \$0.09 to \$1.52 per foot depending on type and specifications.

Material Costs

The cost of indoor fiber optic cable varies based on fiber type, strand count, and jacket construction. Single-mode fiber (OS2) is generally less expensive per foot than multimode fiber (OM3/OM4), but multimode is preferred for high-speed, short-distance applications like data centers or office networks. Retail prices for indoor cables range from \$1 to \$6 per foot, while bulk or wholesale purchases can cost \$0.09 to \$1.52 per foot. A simple 1-core FTTH drop cable may cost around \$0.13 per foot, whereas a 288-strand backbone cable can reach \$6 per foot. Pre-terminated cables and patch cords are more expensive due to factory termination and connector type .

Installation Costs

If you include installation, costs increase depending on cable length, labor, and complexity. For indoor runs, labor rates typically range from \$0.60 to \$3.00 per foot, with additional costs for connectors, patch panels, and permits. A basic 1,000-foot indoor single-mode run with minimal termination may total \$2,650-\$3,100, including materials and labor. Larger or more complex projects, such as multi-story buildings or high-strand-count cables, can significantly increase total costs .

Factors Affecting Price

- o Fiber Type: Single-mode vs multimode; multimode is more expensive for high-speed applications.
- o Strand Count: More strands increase material cost.
- o Jacket Type: Plenum-rated or LSZH jackets for indoor safety add to cost.
- o Pre-Termination: Factory-terminated cables reduce labor but increase material cost.
- o Project Size: Longer runs and multiple drops increase total cost.
- o Local Labor Rates: Urban areas may have higher installation costs than suburban or rural locations .
