

Price of wiring for 10 Gigabit optical modules

The cost of wiring for 10 Gigabit Ethernet optical modules varies widely, typically ranging from \$10-\$50 for short DAC cables, \$20-\$100 for fiber optic cables, and \$1-\$5 per foot for Cat6a copper cabling, depending on length, type, and quality.

Fiber Optic Cabling for 10G SFP+ Modules

For 10G SFP+ modules, fiber optic cables are commonly used for longer distances. 10GBASE-SR multimode fiber supports distances up to 300 meters over OM3 fiber, while 10GBASE-LR single-mode fiber can reach up to 10 km over OS1 fiber . Prices for fiber optic cables depend on length and connector type (typically LC duplex). Short runs (1-5 meters) of multimode fiber can cost \$20-\$50, while longer single-mode cables may range from \$50-\$100 or more .

Direct Attach Copper (DAC) Cables

DAC cables are a cost-effective alternative for short-range connections (up to 10 meters). These are pre-terminated copper cables with SFP+ connectors on both ends. Short DAC cables (1-5 meters) typically cost \$10-\$50, making them ideal for rack-to-rack connections in data centers .

10GBASE-T Copper Cabling (Cat6/Cat6a)

For 10GBASE-T over twisted-pair copper, Cat6a cables are recommended for distances up to 100 meters, while Cat6 is limited to 55 meters . Pricing is usually \$1-\$5 per foot, depending on cable quality, shielding, and vendor. For example, a 50-foot Cat6a cable may cost around \$50-\$100. This option is flexible but slightly higher in latency and power consumption compared to DAC or fiber solutions.

Summary of Cost Considerations

- o Short-range DAC cables (1-10m): \$10-\$50
- o Multimode fiber (up to 300m): \$20-\$50 for short runs, higher for longer lengths
- o Single-mode fiber (up to 10 km): \$50-\$100+ depending on length
- o Cat6a copper cabling (up to 100m): \$1-\$5 per foot

When planning a 10GbE deployment, consider distance, flexibility, and budget. DAC cables are cheapest for short distances, fiber is preferred for long distances, and Cat6a provides a balance of flexibility and cost for structured cabling .
