

Quota for partitions of hot-dip galvanized cable trays

Partitioning of hot-dip galvanized cable trays depends on tray type, load, and environmental conditions, with typical support spacing ranging from 1.5 to 3 meters for standard industrial applications.

General Guidelines

Hot-dip galvanized cable trays are designed to support heavy cable loads while resisting corrosion in harsh environments . The partitioning or spacing between supports (often referred to as "quotas") ensures that the trays maintain structural integrity and prevent sagging or deformation under load.

- o Support Spacing: For standard perforated or solid trays, supports are typically installed every 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray width, thickness, and cable weight . Wider trays or those carrying heavier cables may require closer spacing.
- o Tray Width Considerations: Narrow trays (up to 150 mm) can often span longer distances, while wider trays (300 mm or more) require more frequent supports to maintain rigidity .
- o Partitioning for Large Diameter Cables: When transporting large or heavy cables, it is recommended to divide the tray into sections using internal partitions or dividers to prevent cable crowding and allow proper ventilation .
- o Perforated vs Solid Trays: Perforated trays allow better airflow and heat dissipation, which may reduce the need for additional partitions, whereas solid trays may require more frequent supports to prevent bending under concentrated loads .

Installation Considerations

- o Outdoor and Harsh Environments: Hot-dip galvanized trays exposed to weather or chemical environments should follow the lower end of support spacing to account for potential corrosion and thermal expansion .
- o Vertical and Horizontal Runs: Vertical runs may require closer support spacing than horizontal runs to prevent cable slippage. Horizontal runs should maintain a consistent slope for drainage if perforated trays are used .
- o Custom Partitioning: Many manufacturers, such as JLH Electric and Artim Metal, offer custom sizes and partitions to accommodate specific project requirements, including widths from 50 mm to 1000 mm and lengths from 2 to 6 meters .
