

Recommended Size Table for Distribution Boxes

Article Overview

Distribution box size should be selected based on the number of circuits, total load, and future expansion, with common residential panels ranging from 1-way to 42-slot configurations.

Key Considerations for Sizing

- o Number of Circuits: Count all circuits including lighting, outlets, HVAC, and specialty loads. Residential main panels typically range from 20 to 42 slots to accommodate modern electrical demands, including EV chargers and HVAC systems ().
- o Load Capacity: Match the box to the total electrical load. For modern homes, 200A panels are standard, while smaller workshops or retrofits may require lower-rated panels ().
- o Future Expansion: Always allow extra space for additional circuits or upgrades. Choosing a slightly larger box prevents overcrowding and reduces the risk of overheating ().
- o Material and Protection: Boxes are available in metal or polycarbonate, with protection ratings from IP65 to IP67 for industrial or outdoor environments. High-protection units are preferred for workshops or harsh conditions ().

Industrial Wall Distributor	12-36	500-800 x 400-600 mm	High-protection IP67, pre-wired units for workshops or factories ()
