

Article Overview

To set up a network switch and router, connect the switch to the router via Ethernet, power on both devices, and configure the router for DHCP while optionally managing the switch for VLANs and device access.

Physical Setup

- o **Gather Equipment:** You will need a router, a network switch, Ethernet cables, and power supplies for each device .

Switch Configuration

- o **Unmanaged Switch:** Typically works out-of-the-box; no additional configuration is required .
- o **Managed Switch:** Connect via console using software like Putty, assign a hostname, configure VLANs, and set management IP addresses . Delete any previous VLAN configurations if using a spare switch and verify VTP domain settings to ensure proper VLAN propagation .
- o **Verify Functionality:** Check indicator lights and test connectivity by connecting devices to the switch .

Best Practices

- o **Use Wired Connections:** For optimal speed and reliability, connect devices via Ethernet rather than relying solely on Wi-Fi .
