- o Access the router's admin panel via a browser to configure network settings, such as Wi-Fi name, password, and security options .

- o Keep fiber connectors clean and avoid bending the cable sharply to prevent signal loss .
- o Use high-quality Ethernet cables between the ONT and router to maintain optimal speeds .
