

Size parameters of a four-port information panel for campus network

Article Overview

A standard four-port information panel typically measures 1U in height (1.75 inches), 19 inches in width, and 2-3 inches in depth.

Standard Dimensions

- o Height: 1U (1.75 inches / 44.45 mm), which is the standard unit for rack-mounted panels.
- o Width: 19 inches (482.6 mm), compatible with standard network racks and enclosures.
- o Depth: Usually ranges from 2 to 3 inches (50-75 mm), sufficient to accommodate RJ45 connectors and cable management.

Additional Considerations

- o Port Layout: Four ports are typically arranged in a single row, with spacing to allow easy insertion and removal of Ethernet cables.
- o Mounting: Panels are designed for 19-inch rack compatibility, with mounting holes aligned to standard rack rails. Some panels also support wall-mount brackets for smaller installations.
- o Labeling and Identification: Most panels include a labeling area above or below each port for network documentation.
- o Cable Management: Optional rear cable management brackets or clips help maintain organized cabling and reduce strain on connectors.

Variations

- o Some four-port panels may be slimmer or deeper depending on the manufacturer or if they include integrated features like PoE pass-through, shielding, or fiber adapters.
- o Panels designed for surface-mount boxes may have smaller widths (around 4-6 inches) but maintain the same port spacing for standard RJ45 connectors. For campus network deployments, these panels are typically used at the access layer, connecting end-user devices to switches, and are designed to integrate seamlessly with structured cabling systems, ensuring scalability and ease of maintenance .
