### Enclosed Racks (Rack Cabinets)

Enclosed racks, also called rack cabinets, feature front and rear doors and side panels, often with locks. They provide enhanced security and environmental control, protecting equipment from unauthorized access, dust, and moisture. These racks are suitable for sensitive equipment and data centers with strict environmental requirements. Standard sizes range from 42U to 48U in height, with widths of 19 inches and depths of 36 to 48 inches. Enclosed racks may include integrated cooling systems to manage heat generated by hardware .

### Wall-Mount Racks

Wall-mount racks are smaller racks attached to walls, ideal for limited-space environments or network closets. They are typically used for lightweight equipment such as switches, patch panels, or small servers. These racks save floor space and are convenient for smaller deployments but have limited weight capacity compared to floor-standing racks .

### 2-Post and 4-Post Racks

o 2-Post Racks (Telco Racks): Consist of two vertical bars supporting equipment. They are lightweight, provide good accessibility, and are suitable for network switches and patch panels, but have limited load capacity .

o 4-Post Racks: Feature four vertical posts with front and rear rails, offering superior stability and higher weight capacity, making them suitable for heavier servers and critical network equipment. They can support thousands of pounds and provide better physical protection .
