

Weight per meter of ladder-type cable tray

Ladder-type cable trays typically weigh between 5 kg/m and 20 kg/m depending on material, width, and construction.

- o Perforation: Perforated trays reduce material volume by 15-30%, lowering weight compared to solid trays .

Load Considerations

- o Ladder trays are designed to support cable loads of approximately 75 kg/m on average, with support spacing typically every 2-3 meters for steel and aluminum trays .
- o FRP trays, being lighter, may require closer support spacing depending on the cable load .
