

What to do if your broadband fiber optic cable is unplugged

Immediate Steps

- o **Ensure Safety:** Fiber optic cables transmit data as light, not electricity, so there is no shock risk. However, avoid bending or handling the cable roughly, as the glass fibers are fragile and can break easily .
- o **Inspect the Cable and Connector:** Check the unplugged end for visible damage, dirt, or bent connectors. Fiber connectors are often small and color-coded (yellow or orange), and even minor contamination can disrupt the signal .
- o **Reconnect Carefully:** Align the fiber connector with the port on your modem, router, or optical network terminal (ONT) and insert it gently until it clicks or fits snugly. Avoid forcing the connector, as misalignment can damage the fiber .

Testing and Troubleshooting

- o **Check Indicator Lights:** Most ONTs or modems have a "LOS" (Loss of Signal) or fiber status LED. If the light turns green after reconnecting, the connection is restored .
- o **Restart Devices:** Power cycle your modem, router, or ONT to ensure the network recognizes the reconnected cable .
- o **Test Internet Connectivity:** Verify that your devices can access the internet. If speeds are slow or intermittent, the cable may be damaged or dirty.

When to Call a Professional

- o **Visible Damage:** If the cable is frayed, cut, or kinked, do not attempt DIY splicing. Fiber repair requires specialized tools like fusion splicers and precise alignment, which are not suitable for home repair .
- o **Persistent Connectivity Issues:** If reconnecting does not restore service, contact your ISP. They can send a technician to inspect and repair the fiber safely .

Preventive Tips

- o **Avoid Sharp Bends:** Fiber cables are sensitive to bending; maintain gentle curves.
- o **Keep Connectors Clean:** Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol if cleaning is needed.
- o **Mark Cable Routes:** Prevent accidental unplugging by labeling or securing cables. By following these steps, you can safely address an unplugged fiber optic cable and determine whether professional intervention is necessary to restore reliable broadband service .
