

Where should the main distribution box be wired from

A distribution box should be wired from the main power supply, connecting the phase and neutral to the main MCB, with proper grounding to ensure safety and compliance.

Main Power Connection

The distribution box receives its power from the main supply line. For single-phase systems, the phase and neutral wires from the incoming supply are connected to the input terminals of the main MCB or main switch inside the box. This main MCB acts as the primary protective device, controlling the flow of electricity to all branch circuits. In three-phase systems, each phase is connected to the corresponding input terminals of the main breaker.

Branch Circuit Wiring

From the main MCB, power is distributed to RCCBs or branch MCBs. For double-pole MCBs, both phase and neutral are connected to the output of the RCCB before feeding the load MCBs. Single-pole MCBs typically receive only the phase wire from the RCCB output, while the neutral is connected to the neutral bus bar. Each branch circuit should be wired according to its load requirements, using the correct wire gauge and color coding (e.g., blue for neutral, red/yellow/green for phases), .

Grounding

All metallic parts of the distribution box, including the enclosure, must be reliably grounded. The earth wire can come from the main supply or an earthing pit and should be connected to the earth bus bar inside the box. Proper grounding prevents electric shock and ensures safe operation of protective devices.

Safety and Compliance

Before wiring, ensure the power is completely cut off and verify with a tester. Use insulated tools and personal protective equipment. Maintain neat wiring with cable ties, allow space for heat dissipation, and label all circuits clearly. Follow local electrical codes and standards such as NEC, IEC, or regional regulations to ensure compliance and safety.
