The yellow-green wire in a distribution box is a protective earth (PE) conductor that safely directs fault current to the ground, preventing electric shock.

Purpose of the Yellow-Green Wire

The yellow-green wire is specifically used for protective earthing in electrical systems. Its main function is to provide a low-impedance path for leakage or fault currents from equipment enclosures to the ground, reducing the risk of electric shock to people when insulation fails or metal parts become energized . It is not a current-carrying conductor under normal operation and serves purely as a safety measure .

Color Coding Standards

The yellow-green striped color is internationally recognized according to IEC standards. The alternating stripes every 25 mm make the wire highly visible and distinguishable from live or neutral conductors, even for individuals with color vision deficiencies . Most countries, including EU and UK regions, enforce this standard, while the US may use solid green or bare copper for grounding .

Correct Connection in a Distribution Box

To ensure safe operation, the yellow-green grounding wire should be connected as follows :

- o Locate the PE or grounding bar inside the distribution box.
- o Connect the ground wire from the power supply to the PE bar using a copper core wire of adequate cross-sectional area.
- o Ground electrical components inside the box by connecting them to the PE bar with copper wires.
- o Secure connections by stripping the wire, inserting it into the terminal, and tightening the screw to prevent looseness.
- o Mark the grounding wire clearly for inspection and maintenance. Using a yellow-green insulated copper wire ensures both good conductivity and a clear visual warning of its protective function .

Safety Considerations

- o Always switch off the breaker before working on any wiring .
- o Ensure the grounding system complies with local electrical codes and specifications.
- o The PE wire works in conjunction with circuit breakers or RCDs/GFCIs, which disconnect power during leakage events, enhancing safety . By following these standards and connection practices, the yellow-green grounding wire effectively protects both equipment and personnel from electrical hazards.
